

SEC. 1. STUDENTS WHO TRANSFER WITH AN IEP

a. Texas Transfers

When a student transfers to Texas College Preparatory Academies from another school within Texas, Texas College Preparatory Academies shall provide a free appropriate public education (“FAPE”) to the student. Texas College Preparatory Academies shall provide comparable services as those described in the individualized education program (“IEP”) the student transferred with until Texas College Preparatory Academies adopts the student’s IEP from the previous school, or develops, adopts, and implements a new IEP.

b. Out-of-State Transfers

If the student with a disability transfers to Texas College Preparatory Academies from a school outside of Texas, Texas College Preparatory Academies shall provide the student with FAPE, including comparable services, until Texas College Preparatory Academies conducts an evaluation and develops, adopts, and implements a new IEP.

A new IEP must be implemented within 30 school days from the date the student is verified as being a student eligible for special education services.

If a student transfers from Texas College Preparatory Academies, Texas College Preparatory Academies will furnish the student’s special education records to the student’s new school not later than the 10th working day after the date a request for the information is received by Texas College Preparatory Academies. *19 TAC 89.1050(j)(3).*
