Fiscal Policies Manual - Requested Revision Remove Dual Signature Check Requirement

September 8, 2023

## Background

- There is a sentence in the Fiscal Policies Manual that requires two signatures on all checks greater than $\$ 10,000$
- The 1st signature is the system-generated signature of the Texas CFO
- The 2nd signature must be signed by hand typically via the COO or CEO
- Because of this requirement ResponsiveEd has been reluctant to adopt widespread utilization of electronic payments (ACH/Automated Clearing House) despite many benefits:
- Less opportunity for fraud
- Lower processing costs
- Less administrative work including printing, sorting, signing and mailing checks
- Fewer instances of checks being "lost in the mail" requiring stop payments and reissuing of checks
- More control on the timing of payments


## Requested Revision to Signature Authorities Remove Dual Signature Check Requirement

To properly segregate duties within ResponsiveEd, the Chief Executive Officer, Chief Operating Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Vice President of Finance and Chief Legal Officer are the only individuals with check signatory authority and are responsible for approving all cash transactions. Ghecks drawn on the accounts of ResponsiveEd to satisfy expenditures in oxcess of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) will require the signatures of twosigning offieers.

To further segregate duties within ResponsiveEd, only individuals with appropriate authority at corporate, regional and campus may approve purchase requests, expense reports, or invoices. The approval levels will be as follows:

| $\$ 500$ or less | As authorized by the CEO |
| :--- | :--- |
| $\$ 2,000$ or less | Senior managers, regional managers, finance managers, or brand superintendents |
| $\$ 5,000$ or less | Director of Finance (Arkansas transactions) |
| $\$ 10,000$ or less | Director of Finance (Texas transactions), Vice President of Finance |
| $\$ 20,000$ or less | CEO, COO or CFO |
| $\$ 20,000$ to $\$ 50,000$ | CEO, COO, or CFO, and any other CXO |
| Over $\$ 50,000$ | Board of Directors unless approved in the annual budget |

## Pros \& Cons of Eliminating Dual Signature Check Requirement

## Pros

- Enables increased frequency of electronic/ACH payments
- Currently only $\sim 20-25 \%$ of payments are electronic / the rest are somewhat antiquated paper checks
- No vendors with payments frequently above $\$ 10,000$ are set up for ACH due to the dual signature check requirement
- Approvals for individual invoices (not payments) are already done electronically per the workflow process
- All invoices $>\$ 10,000$ require C-level electronic approval before they are paid
- Eliminates need for $\mathrm{COO} / \mathrm{CEO}$ to hand sign dual signature checks on a recurring basis
- The instance of checks being rejected via the dual signature control are very infrequent
- Once again all invoices already require C-level electronic approval prior to the payment process
- Enhances efficiency of the Accounts Payable staff
- AP staff must manually change ACH payments to checks for vendors set up as ACH in the system for those payments over $\$ 10,000$
- Compiling printed backup to provide the COO/CEO when signing paper checks is not an insignificant task
- AP staff must print and mail paper checks
- Enables potential future payment enhancements including virtual credit card (with rebate) or AP payment automation


## Con

- The only control we lose is C-level visibility of multiple smaller invoices to one vendor when combined the total payment is over $\$ 10,000$
- Typically happens with vendors used by multiples campuses including Staples, Amazon, etc
- Custom reporting can be generated for specific concerns

## Sec. 1. Married Students

Married students have the same rights and responsibilities as unmarried students. This includes the right to participate in any extracurricular activities on the same basis, and subject to the same requirements, as unmarried students.

If the District receives federal funds, it shall not apply any rule concerning a student's actual or potential marital status that treats students differently on the basis of sex. 20 U.S.C. 1681; 34 CFR 106.40.

Except as expressly provided by law, a student who has been married in accordance with Texas law has the capacity and power of an adult, regardless of age. Family Code 1.104.

## Sec. 2. Pregnant Students

The District shall not discriminate against any student or exclude any student from its education program or activity, including any class or extracurricular activity, on the basis of the student's pregnancy, childbirth, false pregnancy, termination of pregnancy, or recovery therefrom, unless the student requests voluntarily to participate in a separate portion of the District's program or activity.

Pregnant students have the right to continue their education during pregnancy and may choose to exercise that right by:

1. Remaining in the regular school program.
2. Participating in any other special program the District may provide for pregnant students.

The student may also choose to request a leave of absence. Such a request shall be accompanied by a licensed physician's certification that the leave is a medical necessity. Students who avail themselves of this option are exempt from compulsory attendance during the period certified by the physician as necessary for the leave of absence.

The District may require such a student to obtain the certification of a physician that the student is physically and emotionally able to continue participation in the normal education program or activity so long as such certification is required of all students for other physical or emotional conditions requiring the attention of a physician.

## Sec. 3. Pregnancy Related Services

In accordance with the Student Attendance Accounting Handbook ("SAAH"), Pregnancy Related Services (PRS) are support services, including Compensatory Education Home

Instruction (CEHI), that a pregnant student receives during the pregnancy prenatal and postpartum periods, that are designed to help students adjust academically, mentally and physically and stay in school.

The District may choose whether to offer a PRS program. If the District chooses to offer a PRS program, it must offer CEHI services as part of that program. PRS program services are delivered to a student when:

1. The student is pregnant and attending classes on campus;
2. A valid medical necessity for confinement during the pregnancy prenatal period prevents the student from attending classes on campus; or
3. a valid medical necessity for confinement during the pregnancy postpartum period prevents the student from attending classes on campus.

19 Tex. Admin. Code 129.1025; (SAAH SECTION 9)
CEHI provides academic services to the student at home or hospital bedside when a valid medical necessity for confinement during the pregnancy prenatal or postpartum periods prevent the student from attending classes on a district campus. CEHI must consist of face-to-face contact with a certified teacher or substitute providing academic services to the student. The CEHI teacher must maintain a log to document the actual amount of prenatal and postpartum CEHI each student receives. Without an On-Campus PRS Waiver, or a Remote Homebound Instruction Waiver, CEHI services must be provided in the home or at the hospital bedside.
"Remote instruction" for the PRS program means that CEHI is provided to a student through a technology that allows for real-time, two-way interaction between a student and teacher who are in different physical locations. Examples of such technology are interactive video conferencing and a robot that allows for virtual interaction between student and teacher. The technology must allow for both two-way audio and two-way video interaction and all other SAAH PRS requirements must be met.

PRS support services should not interfere with academic services while on the school campus or receiving CEHI at home or hospital bedside. Examples of support services the District may choose to offer are:

1. counseling services including the initial session when the student discloses the pregnancy;
2. health services including from the school nurse;
3. transportation for the student or the student's children to school, child care facility, community service agencies, health services etc.;

## Sec. 1. General Homebound Education

In accordance with the Texas Education Agency's Student Attendance Accounting Handbook (SAAH), a student may be eligible for general education homebound services if the student is to be confined for a minimum of four weeks to a hospital or homebound for medical reasons specifically documented by a physician licensed to practice in the United States. The weeks of confinement need not be consecutive. A parent request for such services shall be made through the Headmaster/Campus Director in accordance with the SAAH and administrative procedures.

The Headmaster/Campus Director or designee shall convene a placement committee composed of at least a campus administrator, a teacher of the student, and the student's parent or guardian to consider the necessity of providing general education homebound instruction to the student. If the committee determines that such instruction is appropriate, the committee shall determine the type and amount of instruction to be provided and the length of the transition period when the student is able to return to the regular educational setting, based on current medical information.

## Sec. 2. Special Education Students

Consistent with state rule and the SAAH, a student receiving special education services may be eligible for special education homebound services if the student is to be confined for a minimum of four weeks to hospital or homebound setting for medical reasons specifically documented by a physician licensed to practice in the United States. If a student is chronically ill, the student's admission, review, and dismissal committee shall determine whether the weeks of confinement need be consecutive.

If the ARD committee determines that homebound instruction is appropriate, the committee shall determine the type and amount of instruction to be provided in accordance with law and, if applicable, the length of the transition period to the school-based setting based on current medical information.

19 TAC 89.1005(c)(2)

## Sec. 3. Documentation of Services

The District shall maintain full documentation regarding students receiving homebound services in accordance with administrative procedures, the SAAH, and the student's individualized education program, as applicable.
